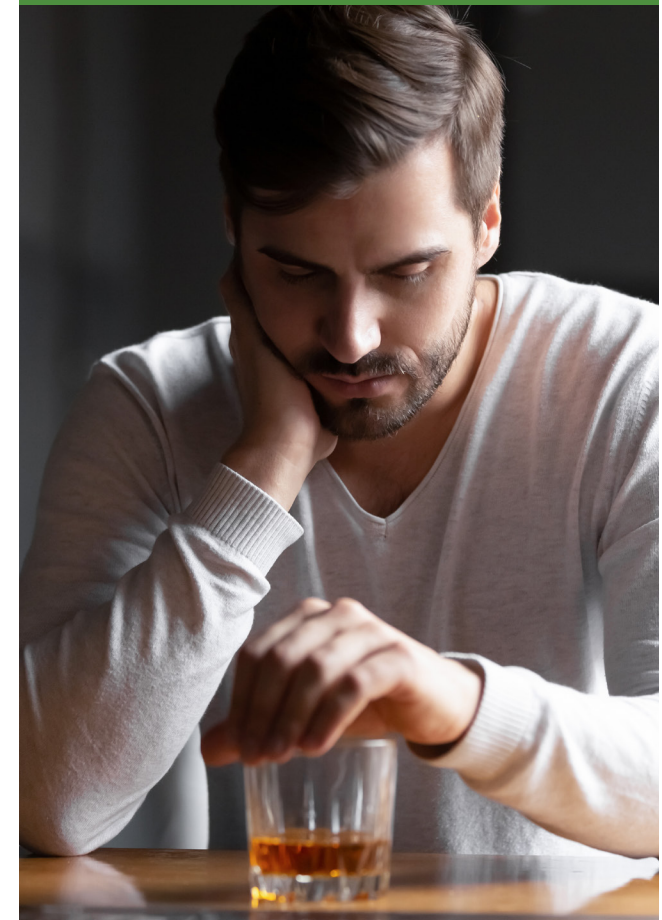

Substance Use Disorder Treatment Services

Substance use disorder (SUD) is a disease that alters a person's brain and behavior leading to uncontrolled use of illegal and legal drugs and substances, including alcohol.

Symptoms and Behaviors

Financial issues - sudden requests for financial assistance without explanation and spending money on drugs in place of other high-priority expenses, such as food and bills

Neglected appearance - lack of interest in looks or personal hygiene

Physical health issues - lack of energy and motivation, weight loss or gain, and needing more of the drug to obtain the same effect

Problems at school or work - decreased performance or frequent absences

Potential Risk Factors

- Family history of addiction
- Pre-existing mental health disorder
- Peer pressure
- Taking a highly addictive medication
- Use from an early age

In 2022, there were 55 opioid and drug overdose deaths and 624 EMS responses to drug overdoses in Indian River County; one of the highest rates of drug overdoses per county in the state of Florida.

Our board certified and licensed team of psychiatrists, psychiatric nurse practitioners, mental health counselors, and clinical social workers are here to help you and your loved ones during this critical time.

The SUD program at TCCH utilizes a variety of approaches and support systems:

- Case management
- Individual sessions
- Medications for treatment, such as Suboxone and Vivitrol
- Substance abuse and mental health evaluations

Low-Cost Medicine

TCCH Fellsmere, Gifford, and Oslo health centers have in-house pharmacies and offer the lowest medication prices in Indian River County.

Taking medication, as prescribed, leads to better health, and affordable medicine makes it easier to stay healthy. TCCH patients can pick up medicine as they leave the office, use delivery and mail order services at no cost, refill their prescriptions with the RefillRx mobile app, and can ask for price match.
